1.2 Health & Safety Law references

The laws concerning Health and Safety in France are national laws. There are no additional local/regional regulations.

The main requirements in Health and Safety are described in the “Code du Travail” (Labour Act). However, for some specific topics not covered by the Labour Act, additional requirements are specified under the form of specific laws (act, decree, etc). These specific laws are issued on a regular basis. The requirements coming from these specific laws will sometimes amend the Labour Act.

The Labour Act is made of several parts, titles, chapters, sections and articles. For instance the requirement R4227-37 is the article 37 of part 4, title 2, chapter 2, section 7 of the Labour Act.
